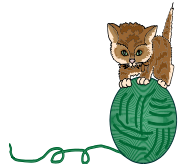

Please remember we are **OUTSIDE ALL DAY**—getting dirty is part of the fun! Put a swimsuit **and towel in your child's backpack**—you never know when **we're going to get wet!** You may also want to put something on the seats (and floor) of **your vehicle so it doesn't get wet or dirty.**
