**Program Highlights:**

The campers in the CIT program will participate in daily leadership training sessions. Throughout the summer topics such as health and safety, leadership, planning and programming, and teambuilding will be discussed. The CITs will have opportunities to implement what they have learned throughout the day by actively participating in groups lead by camp staff.

Participants are expected to follow all camp policies as well as rules and guidelines set forth by the CIT Coordinator at all times. If a member of the program cannot, or does not, fulfill the expectations set forth by the CIT Coordinator, a conference will be held with the CIT's parent(s), and the CIT may be removed from the program. Expectations will be explained at the start of each week.

CITs will be attending weekly field trips and they will participate in weekly cookouts.

On Fridays, the CITs will be recognized at the Grand Council Fire where they will receive an award for their accomplishments throughout the week. The ceremony will start at 2:45 p.m. Parents are welcome to attend.
