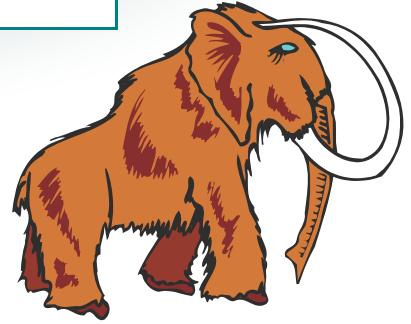

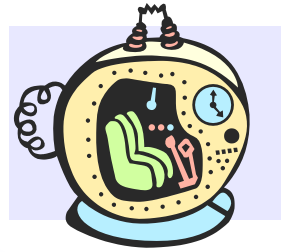

Attention Parents:

Please note that morning drop off is from 8:45 am to 9:00 am, and afternoon pick up is from 4:00 pm to 4:15 pm. Late arrivals and early pick ups mean your camper misses out on activities that may not be repeated during the week. If you need to drop off late or pick up early, please notify camp staff at 630-759-9723 at least one day in advance if at all possible, so they can be properly prepared.



JUST A FEW REMINDERS...

PLEASE DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD IN SANDALS OR FLIPPLOPS.

FOR THEIR SAFETY, CAMPERS MUST BE IN A CLOSED TOE SHOE!!

Don't forget to send EVERYDAY:

1. FULL water bottle
2. a nutritious snack
3. a lunch (except for Friday)
4. sunscreen, and bug spray (enough for the whole week)

Afternoon pick up starts at 4:00 pm and ends at 4:15 pm. Anyone picking up after 4:15 pm will be charged according to the policy

stated in the parent packet.

Please be sure to check your child's backpack daily: Important handouts, as well as crafts your child has done while at camp, will be in their backpack.

Don't forget to label all of your child's belongings with their name, **ESPECIALLY WATER BOTTLES!!**
It's a good idea to send your child

in clothes that can get dirty. Please remember we are **OUTSIDE ALL DAY**—getting dirty is part of the fun! Put a swimsuit and towel in your child's backpack—you never know when we're going to get wet!

You may also want to cover the seats (and floor) of your vehicle so it doesn't get wet or dirty.
